

Summer Intensive Reading Programs
At Full Spectrum Student Services

We have decided on our offerings and want you to be the first to know. We have a few possibilities for you to consider based on your needs and budget.

Choice 1) Summer Intensive Reading Groups: (For struggling readers) we will be holding two groups, one for rising first graders and one for rising second graders. They will each have a limit of SIX students, and will be held from July 5th-July 23rd. Both will run 5 days a week.

Rising 1st Grade Group: 1:00-2:30, M-F (15 sessions)

Rising 2nd Grade Group: 3:00-4:30, M-F (15 sessions)

This program is intensive, will involve a three week commitment, and will achieve results. It will be an accelerated version of the Wilson Foundations curriculum and will include a pre-and post assessment given by a certified Wilson Reading Instructor. The Foundations curriculum is designed to reduce the number of children who later need intervention by giving students a solid foundation in print concepts, phonemic awareness, high frequency words, fluency, spelling, and handwriting. It also pinpoints areas of struggle for children who may be dyslexic.

90 minute sessions are lengthy for this age group, so we will be taking creative breaks to move and incorporate some art and sensory activities. Think of it as a three week camp for struggling readers. The cost will be \$275 and you can register for your spot online at:

Choice 2) Intensive Private Reading Program: (For struggling readers) This program will include **20, 90 minute sessions**, scheduled and completed on YOUR schedule with a personal tutor. It will include an initial consultation with our Certified Wilson Reading Instructor, who will tailor a personalized program fit to your child's specific needs using the Foundations Ready to Rise curriculum. She will set your child up with one of our tutors to implement the program and provide ongoing support throughout the process. This program can be completed **at our location OR at your home**. Your tutor will schedule around your family and include a post assessment. **Sessions do not expire** and can continue into the school year to be used at any time.

Cost: \$50/session (at location) \$60/session (in your home) Payment Plan available

Choice 3) Regular tutoring option: Call or email our office and Jenny, our office manager, will take some initial information and set you up with a free, 30 minute, initial assessment with one of our tutors. At that assessment, your tutor will listen to your needs, work with your child a bit, and create a differentiated plan to address them. Sessions can be 30 or 60 minutes in length.

Cost: \$25/half hour or \$40/hr (at location or through Zoom)

\$30/half hour or \$50/hr (in-home)
